1. The following aircraft aborted from the mission  
of 25 June, 1944, due to the reasons stated:

a. Aircraft #44-6146 returned early because of  
loss of pressure in Navigators oxygen system. Ground check  
revealed materiel failure of oxygen pressure gage. (Mechanical)

b. Aircraft #42-37511 returned early because  
indicated fuel pressure on #2 engine dropped to zero, immedi-  
ately after the ship was hit by flak. The pilot feathered the  
prop and was unable to stay with the formation on three engines.  
Upon return a ground check showed that the line from the fuel  
pressure transmitter to indicator had been cut by flak, causing  
a drop in indicated fuel pressure, while the fuel pressure  
actually remained constant. (Other)


