MISSION SUMMARY REPORT

MISSION # 170

Date 16 November 1944

ASSIGNMENT

1. Assigned Target: ESCHWEILER, GERMANY
2. Commitments: The 401st Group was to furnish three 12 A/C squadrons for the 94th "C" Group. A GH ship was furnished by the 384th Group and a PFF A/C was scheduled for each formation. A spare was to accompany each squadron.

3. Flight Over England:
 - a. Takeoff: Takeoff was on time and normal except that visibility was restricted, necessitating an instrument takeoff and climb.

MISSION SUMMARY REPORT (Cont)3. Flight Over England: (Cont)

- b. Sqdn and Gp Assemblies: A normal assembly was made over Cottesmore Buncher. All of the Group was in formation before leaving the Buncher for point "A".
- c. Route Over England: Group departed Buncher 3 minutes late so had to cut across at Point "A" (beginning of Wing assembly line). While on Wing a ssembly line information was received that 94th "B" would not be in proper Wing position so 401st Group as 94th "C" took up position directly behind 94th "A" and was therefore number two in Division column instead of number three as briefed. Division assembly line was from English coast to French coast.

4. Attack:

- a. Flight to Target: Flight to target was exsentially as briefed except the 94th "C" was second in Division instead of briefed third. Four minutes before IP the Deputy Lead took over lead as planned in the event that target was not visual, and we continued on the bomb run.
- b. Bombing Run: At Deputy Lead we took over the lead at the IP as planned. Gee Navigator started a very good run. A few minutes before bombs away his interphone went out so he had to write all course corrections down to be relayed to the pilot. At bombs away the whole group was in formation and all bombs were trained out. Cloud cover was 8/10-10/10ths, results being unobserved. AFCE worked satisfactorily.
- c. Flight from Target: When turn was made to west out of Germany the lead was again assumed by Group Air Commander, depty moving back to his previously assigned position. No flak was encountered on return route.
- d. Return to Base: Descent was begun in France so that altitude of 10,000' was reached when English coast was crossed. At a point over splasher #10 Group letdown to 1,000' and returned to base under overcast with low and high squadrons in trail of lead, in that order. Five ships landed at home base and the rest were diverted to Ossington. Twenty five landed there and others at scattered fields.
- e. Weather: Weather enroute was described as 6/10-7/10ths strata cumulus, tops approximately 12,000', increasing to 9/10ths over target with tops approximately the same.
- f. Fighter Support: Fighters offered area protection and it was good.
- g. Comments on Formation: Formation was good except that High squadron was stretched out until IP was reached. Group was good as a whole.
- h. Conclusions and Recommendations: ⁴one.

 - a. Observations: Bombfall was unobserved but from all indications they fell within assigned area.

b. Disposition of Bombs:

Lead Squadron: 12 Scheduled A/C entered enemy territory and bombed the target, dropping 341 X 260# Frags. A/C #313 returned 3 bombs, and A/C #565 returned 14 due to rack malfunction. The spare returned jettisoning its load of 30 frags in the channel.

Low Squadron: 12 Scheduled A/C entered enemy territory and bombed the target, dropping 358 X 260# Frags. The spare returned and jettisoned its 30 bombs in channel.

High Squadron: 12 Scheduled A/C entered enemy territory and bombed the target, dropping 357 X 260# Frags. The spare returned early after jettisoning its 30 bombs in channel.

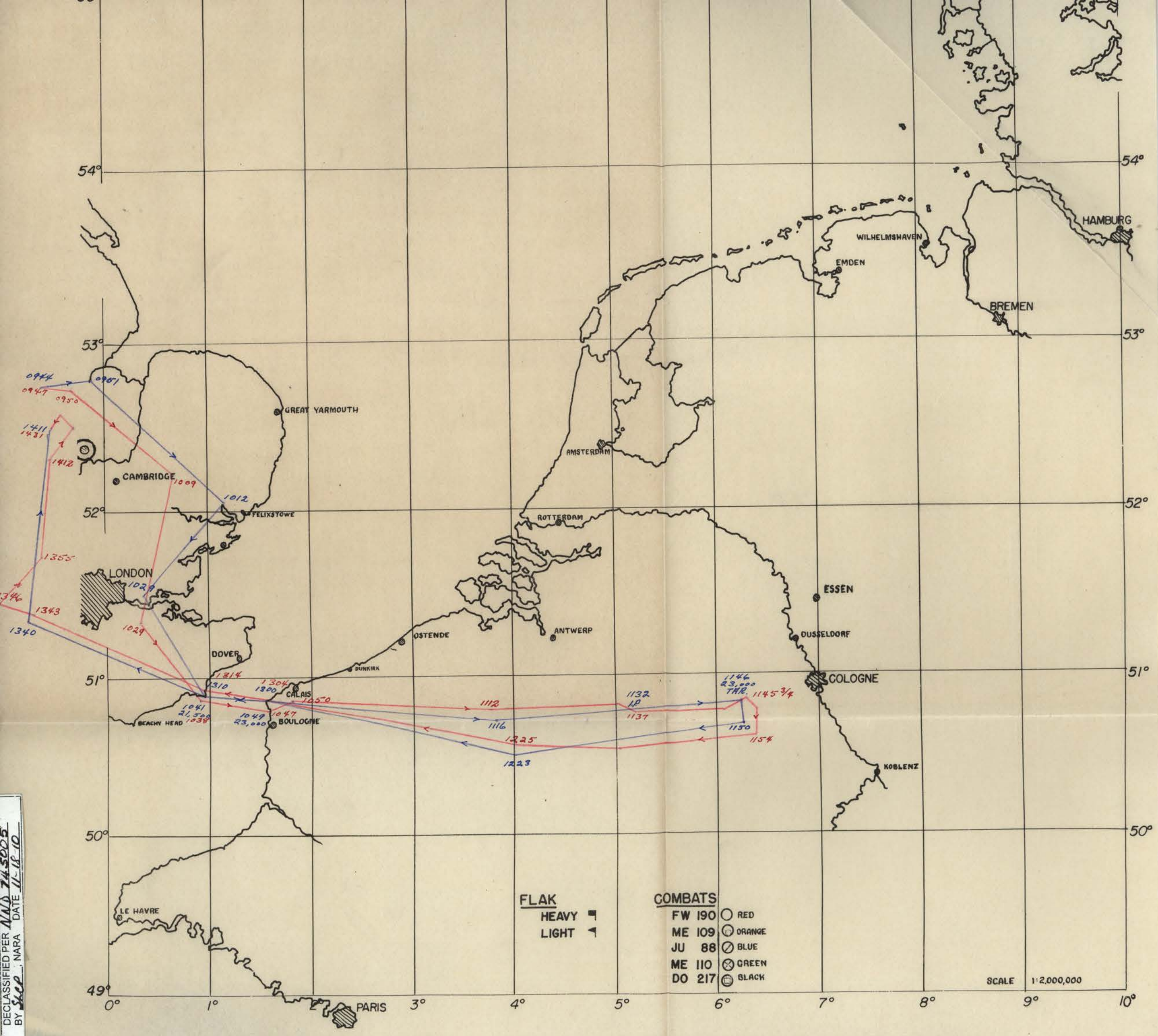

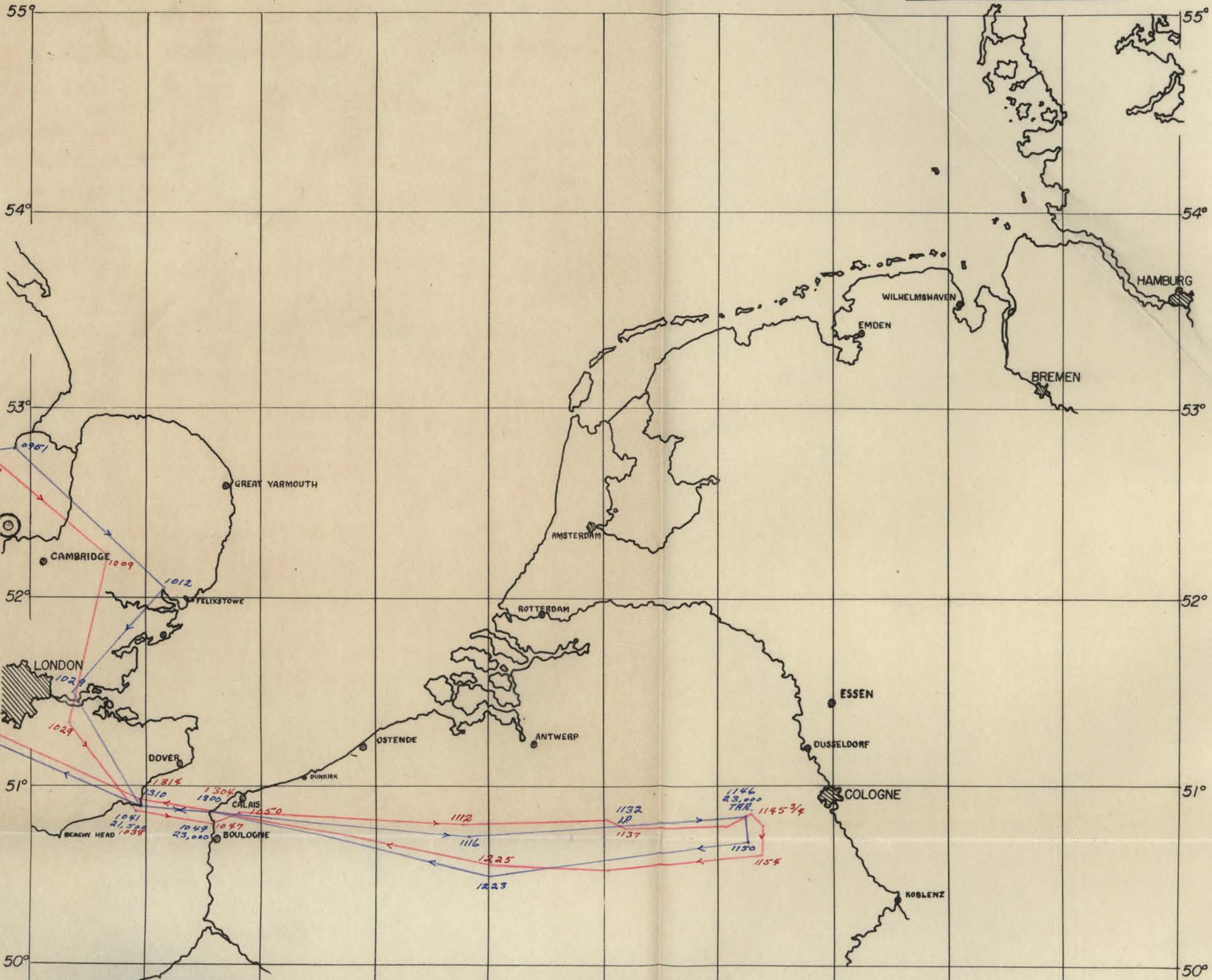
